Curriculum Newsletter Autumn 2

Dear parents and carers,

Please find below an outline of Year 3L's curriculum for this half term. If you have any questions regarding the curriculum this half term then please speak to one of the team.

<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Following on from last half term, we have selected Egypt to look at in more detail. This will include mummification, position on the River Nile and everyday life of a settlement.</p> 	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>This term we will be starting our creative writing with Roald Dahl's Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. This will follow Charlie's journey in his escape from poverty to the magical land of chocolate!</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>In maths we will be learning all about measurement. This will include length and weight. It will also link into our English narrative with some chocolate bar creation.</p> 
<p><u>Philosophy</u></p> <p>In order to develop children's thinking and questioning skills, children will also continue to have Philosophy sessions. This has proved very beneficial and has developed the children's ability to work in groups and value other peoples' opinions and views.</p> 	<p><u>Religious Education</u></p> <p>This half term in R.E we will be looking at what it means to be a Christian in Britain today and how we can apply the values in our everyday lives.</p> 	<p><u>Physical Education</u></p> <p>In P.E this half term we will be learning how to play netball. We will be working on our hand eye coordination and accuracy. Communication and spacial awareness will also be key.</p> 
<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Computing will enhance our other subject areas this term. We will use Apps and programs to present findings on different topics, learning when technology can achieve a better outcome. We will also develop our searching skills, understanding how to be an effective researcher. Alongside all of this, we will discuss the importance of e-Safety.</p> 	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>This half term in science we will be continuing our project on light, working on reflection, and utilising natural resources.</p> 	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Optical illusions will be our project this half term. Perspective, distance and line skills will be utilised throughout before creating our own interpretations of active illusions.</p>

- Spellings will be shared on the blog and with the children each week. There will be a spelling test every Friday. Please support your child by practicing their spellings with them.
